## Tahoe Donner Hosts 43<sup>rd</sup> Annual Ski for Light International Week

**Truckee, Calif.** (January 23, 2018) –Sunday, January 21 kicked-off the 43<sup>rd</sup> annual Ski for Light event—an international ski week for visually and mobility-challenged skiers and their guides taking place at the <u>Tahoe Donner Cross Country Ski Center</u> through February 28.

Ski for Light, Inc. is an all-volunteer, non-profit organization founded in 1975. The mission of <u>Ski for Light</u> is to teach visually- and mobility-impaired adults the sport of classic cross-country skiing, to give participants who have already mastered the basics the chance to improve their skills and endurance, and to enable participants to just have fun on the snow. Ski for Light relies on volunteer instructors who are each matched up with a skier as their guide for the week.

"We're proud to be selected as the location for this meaningful event and to be working with such an amazing organization," said Sally Jones Tahoe Donner Cross Country Ski Center manager. "Ski for Light has brought visitors from around the world with a shared purpose of learning new skills, enjoying the outdoors and simply having a great time."

The Ski for Light team and Tahoe Donner will create a 5K and 10K loop for skiers and their guides. Advanced skiers can take part in races and there will be a XC ski rally for those content with touring.

Ski for Light organizers are still seeking volunteers from the greater Truckee area to aid with ski technique sessions on January 24 and to help marshal the ski race and rally course on January 26.
