Special Board Meetings Language

Special meetings of the board can be held between regular meetings to conduct business that cannot wait until the next regularly scheduled board meeting. Boards are required to give notice of special meetings and allow member attendance at such meetings.

II. 12:01 p.m. Member & Director Comments

Property owners' comments are welcomed at this time for matters not on the agenda and are limited to three minutes. However, members may submit additional comments by email to the Board (board@tahoedonner.com). The Board president may recognize members to comment on agenda items as they occur. Members are requested to identify themselves and to include Unit and Lot

Number. Directors and Staff are limited by law to brief responses and clarifying questions to matters not on the agenda. Directors may request Staff to report back to the Board concerning such matters and place the matter on a future Board agenda.

Board meetings are defined by the Davis-Stirling Act as a gathering of a majority of directors at the same time and place to "hear, discuss, or deliberate upon any item of business that is within the authority of the Board." (Civ. Code §4090.) A Board meeting is a meeting of the corporation's Board of Directors, not a meeting of association members. Accordingly, members do not have a right to participate in the Board's discussions and votes. By statute, members can watch the Board conduct business. In addition, they can address the Board during the open forum portion of the meeting. Although members do not have a legal right to participate in Board discussions, the president can invite comments from the audience on particular items of business if he so chooses. This is at the discretion of the Board.
