TAHOE DONNER GIVING FUND 2018 SCHOLARSHIPS

This June, the Tahoe Donner Giving Fund awarded eight scholarships totaling \$12,500 to graduates from Truckee High School, North Tahoe High School and Sierra High School, as well as \$8,000 in continuing education scholarships to graduates from 2015 and 2016.

Giving Fund members Barbara Ramsey and Suzanne Sullivan participated with other affiliates of the Tahoe Truckee Community Foundation (TTCF) in reviewing 118 applications from graduating seniors in the Truckee Tahoe Unified School District and several charter and private schools. Each affiliate came to the table with a list of graduates who met the requirements of the scholarship they applied for, which range from smaller one-time awards to full four-year endowments. To qualify for an award from the Giving Fund, the graduate should:

- Be accepted at a post-secondary twoyear or four-year college or university or an accredited institution offering career technical education
- Demonstrate the capacity for success by having at least a 3.0 GPA based on a 4-point scale
- Demonstrate financial need
- Preference is given to students who are the first in their family to seek postsecondary education
