The 9th Annual Fall Festival Comes to Tahoe Donner Oct. 13

Dogs are welcome, but must be on leash when not in the pool area.

New this year, paid entry is required for all attendees age 2 and older. Entry costs range from \$5-\$25 and includes unlimited access to many of the event activities. Oktoberfest-inspired food and BBQ, seasonal beers and items from Pizza on the Hill will be available for purchase.

A free shuttle bus will provide pick-up and drop-off from 11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. between Trout Creek Recreation Center and Northwoods Clubhouse.
