Donner neighbors – including people and wildlife. You are also required to comply with Tahoe Donner rules and regulations, which are separate to any town, county or state laws.

ENFORCEMENT

Violation of Tahoe Donner's covenants and rules can result in suspension of amenity privileges and fines levied. For more information about rules, enforcement and fines, please call (530) 414-8166.

TAHOE DONNER RULES*



NOISE that is "an unreasonable annoyance or nuisance to neighbor(s)" is prohibited after 10PM.



OUTDOOR LIGHTS OUT after 10PM to enjoy the mountain stars and minimize light pollution.



FIREWORKS AND FIREARMS of any kind are prohibited.



PARKING VEHICLES off-pavement, on other person's property/driveway or on access easements is prohibited.

Note: Town of Truckee winter parking ordinance prohibits parking on streets Nov. 1 to April 30.



PETS must be on leash and under control while at Tahoe Donner facilities. Pick up after your pet and properly dispose of the poop and bags in a waste receptacle



OPEN OUTDOOR FIRES without screens or covers are prohibited without a permit.



SMOKING is prohibited on Tahoe Donnerowned property, this includes facilities/parking lots and open space.



TRASH must be locked up in your bear-proof container, never your neighbors' container or dumped anywhere in Tahoe Donner.



CAMPING on private residences is prohibited, including in tents carts RVs etc.



DRONE USE on Tahoe Donner-owned property, including open space, is prohibited without prior written authorization from the association.



SLOW DOWN on Tahoe Donner streets; the speed limit is predominantly 25 MPH and wildlife, accidents, dogs and children could require sudden stops



USE OF AMENITIES or facilities after closing, either for the day or season, is prohibited.

AMENITY USE + GUEST CARDS

Tahoe Donner is known for its many amenities ranging from restaurants to skiing. Some are open to the general public, while others are open only to members, their guests or visitors with guest cards.

Per the homeowner's discretion, short-term renters may be given a Guest Card to gain access to the private amenities.

- A property may have up to two Transferable Guest Cards.
- A total of four guests per Guest Card may access private amenities at the same time without a member being present.
- After guests pay the entrance fee at one amenity, they will receive a wristband that allows access to the other amenities for the same day.

To keep amenities accessible to everyone, please familiarize yourself with amenity guidelines.

KEEP WILDLIFE WILD!

Tahoe Donner is home to bears and other wildlife. DO NOT FEED THE WILDLIFE! Remember:

- Never put trash/recycling out at the curb prior to Tuesday morning. Do not store pet food outside.
- Close/latch all trash and recycling dumpster lids. Remove key.
- Lock doors and windows when away from the residence.
- Do not keep food items or used food containers in vehicles.

WINTER DRIVING + TIPS

- Between Oct. and May, guests are limited to the number of cars that fit in the paved driveway or in assigned parking. Parking on the street during this period is prohibited by the Town of Truckee and vehicles are subject to towing at owner's expense.
- Be aware of snow loads sliding off roofs; people and pets can be buried and injured.
- Clear all snow from vehicle roof; it can later slide onto windshield and obstruct vision. Carry a window scraper/brush to remove snow and ice from the vehicle.
- The speed limit in Tahoe Donner is predominantly 25 mph or less, depending on road conditions.
- In case of power outage, travel with flashlights, battery-powered radio and batteries.
- Carry tire chains or have snow tires on your vehicle. The Town
 of Truckee can prohibit non-4-wheel drive or AWD vehicles
 without chains from driving up to Tahoe Donner during winter
 snow conditions.
