Women's Mountain Bike Maintenance Series: July 13, Aug. 3

Routine bike maintenance keeps you riding smoothly and prolongs the life of your bike. Join us at Tahoe Donner Bikeworks this summer for a women's mountain bike maintenance series. This introductory class will help you learn how to take care of your bike before, during, and after rides! Time: 4–6 p.m. Cost: Free to Tahoe Donner members. Just \$10 for non-member per session.

Women's Introduction to Mountain Biking Series: July 15, Aug. 5

Learn the basic skills of mountain biking in a women's only environment from certified mountain biking instructors. Our instructors will teach you the basic techniques including shifting, braking, ascending, descending and maneuvering around obstacles. We'll also go over important communication skills and mountain biking trail etiquette with the aim of keeping multi use trails open and safe for everyone. There will be plenty of time out on the trails riding and practicing these new skills. Time: 9 a.m.–1 p.m. Cost: \$149 per session.

FUN-damental Mountain Biking Series for Kids: July 15, Aug. 5

Certified mountain biking instructors will teach the fundamentals of mountain biking to kids ages 9–12 years old. Participants will learn essential bike skills and gain confidence as they go through mountain biking skills progressions including body and pedal position, shifting, braking, climbing, descending, and navigating minor obstacles on the trail. They will learn about trail etiquette and safety while out exploring the Tahoe Donner trail system. Bring plenty of water, food (snack and lunch) and sunscreen. Bike rentals are available. Time: 9 a.m. –1 p.m. Cost: \$149 per session.
