Date: August 3, 2017

Issue:

Repairs and replacements of fire, smoke, and water damage within the dry sauna at the Trout Creek Recreation Center.

Background:

On Friday July 21, there was a fire within the Dry Sauna at the Trout Creek Recreation Center with a plastic lined, wooden water bucket and wooden ladle having been left on top of the heater unit. The fire suppression system functioned as designed to extinguish the fire prior to spread and major damage to building structure; however, the interior of the dry sauna received significant damage from fire, smoke, and water saturation. Staff has solicited a repair and replacement estimate from Mt. Lincoln Construction, Inc, the general contractor of award for the recent remodel in 2016, and estimates damage repair costs of \$17,500. Mt. Lincoln's familiarity with the impacted area, necessary materials, and labor costs has allowed for a timely turnaround in estimate generation for the repairs. Staff recommends contracting with Mt. Lincoln Construction, Inc. for the dry sauna repairs utilizing remaining Replacement Reserve Funds with a budget not to exceed \$20,000 inclusive of contingency

Options:

- 1. Approve contracting with Mt. Lincoln Construction, Inc. for the dry sauna repairs utilizing Replacement Reserve Funds with a budget not to exceed \$20,000 inclusive of contingency.
- 2. Not perform the necessary repairs in hopes that the fire, smoke, and water damage dissipates over time.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the Board of Directors approve Option 1: Approve contracting with Mt. Lincoln Construction, Inc. for the dry sauna repairs utilizing Replacement Reserve - Expense funds with a budget not to exceed \$20,000 inclusive of contingency.

- Material and labor costs to section off construction area, and provide egress as needed during construction. Cover/protect flooring, walls, etc outside construction area as needed.

1513.0 - Job Mobilization:

- Price to mobilize construction equipment, job boxes, scaffolding, etc.

\$100.00

- Price to remove scaffolding, tools, and provide a full demobilization of all contractor and subcontractor equipment.

- Excludes asbestos/lead testing.
- Excludes moving client belongings.
- Excludes increases in scope by code upgrade requirements.






