While the finalization of a formal lessons learned document is completed after major events / activities, capturing lessons learned should occur throughout the year to ensure all information is documented in a timely and accurate manner. Lessons learned documents serve as a valuable tool for use by the management team and planning for future operations and capital acquisitions. This document should not only describe what went wrong and suggestions to avoid similar occurrences in the future, but it should also describe what went well and how similar successes and prior planning may benefit all operations.
