## **Tahoe Donner to Host 'Edi-Bol for Good' Fundraiser Dinner Supporting Sierra Community House**

*Experience authentic Vietnamese five-spiced chicken with your local community and help generate awareness about hunger relief, crisis intervention and prevention, and family resources in North Lake Tahoe and Truckee*

Truckee, Calif. (February 4, 2020) – Tahoe Donner will be hosting a community fundraiser [Edi-Bol for Good](#) in partnership with [Sierra Community House](#) and local food tech start-up [Kynbo](#) on Wednesday, February 26 at Alder Creek Cafe and Trailside Bar.

Chef David Smith will recreate Kynbo co-founder Thao Doan's mother's traditional Vietnamese inspired five-spiced chicken recipe, served with rice and fresh Asian vegetables. A vegetarian option will also be available.

Tickets for the community Edi-Bol fundraiser are \$20 per adult and \$15 per child age 12 and under. A portion of proceeds directly benefit Sierra Community House, dedicated to connecting and empowering the local community through family strengthening, crisis intervention, hunger relief, and legal services.

"We're excited to partner with Tahoe Donner and Kynbo to provide a fun night for our community to come together and enjoy this delicious, authentic Asian dish for a great cause," said Paul Bancroft, executive director of Sierra Community House. "This is a great way for us to educate our friends and neighbors about the 1 in 7 individuals in the North Lake Tahoe/Truckee region that are food insecure."

The Sierra Community House is comprised of four long-standing North Tahoe/Truckee non-profit organizations – Family Resource Center of Truckee, North Tahoe Family Resource Center, Tahoe SAFE Alliance, and Project MANA – offering a range of services that help individuals and families in the North Tahoe/Truckee communities thrive.

Kynbo is known for bringing mouth-watering Asian comfort food to the greater Lake Tahoe and Truckee communities in support of local non-profits through events like Pho for Project MANA. Chef Smith and a handful of other local chefs were taught the secrets of preparing authentic and complex Vietnamese dishes by Thao's mother Mai Doan as a way to pay it forward by helping feed the hungry – the same help she and her husband received when they emigrated to the U.S. in 1975 with seven children.
