Recommended Action

By Motion:

The board of directors authorizes the expenditure of budgeted 2020 Replacement Reserve Funds- Euer Valley Restoration Phase 1 (Coyote Crossing) Soft Costs in the amount of \$150,000.

The board of directors by memorandum of understanding acknowledges the Truckee River Watershed Council as partner, and co-lead for the purposes of applying for, accepting and facilitating the \$589,835.80 State Water Resources Control Board for the 2020 Clean Water Act grant awarded to Truckee River Watershed Council and Tahoe Donner for the Euer Valley Restoration Phase 1 project.

Project Scope

The project area is roughly 30 acres and will include approximately ½ mile of stream channel restoration and 1,200 feet of existing/eroding recreational trails with mix of soft surface and approximately 500 linear feet of boardwalk. Project will include a weight-bearing bridge which will span an approximate length of 75 feet over the south fork of Prosser Creek.

Estimated Project Schedule:

2020 - Studies + Design

2021- Final studies + Permitting

2020 - Implementation / Construction



Funding

Replacement Reserve Fund

- 2020 - \$150,000 for soft costs
- 2022 - \$400,000 crossing and trail replacement

State Water Resource Board Grant - \$589,835.80
