WIDESPREAD

Many non-essential indoor business operations are closed

SUBSTANTIAL

Some non-essential indoor business operations are closed

MODERATE

Some indoor business operations are open with modifications

MINIMAL

Most indoor business operations are open with modifications

Downhill, Cross Country, Snowplay

- Guidance for ski areas released by the State on Dec. 1, 2020
 - Minor modifications to the operating plans as a result
- Regional Stay-at-Home Order initiated on Dec. 11, 2020
 - Skiing still allowed under Stay-at-Home Order Outdoor Recreation Guidance
 - No outdoor dining – tables removed from the deck areas
- **UPDATE : Jan 12** - State lifted the Stay-at-Home Order for the Greater Sacramento area including Nevada County
 - Back to the tier guidance
 - Operating under the CDPH Dec. 1 release for Outdoor Recreation and Ski Area guidance and **purple tier** restaurant guidance with outdoor dining permitted – tables have returned

The Lodge Restaurant and Pub

No change

- Open for take-out only, 7 days a week
- Indoor dining is still not available as is required in **Purple Tier 1**



Trout Creek Recreation Center

- The gym remains closed as required in **Purple Tier 1**
- Lap Pool and Recreation Pool access open 7 days a week from 6 am-7:30 pm is allowed
- Access is available by reservation through our online store
