## Scholarships

At the March 26, 2021 meeting the Board approved expenditures of \$200,000 for four IMPACT scholarships and a maximum of \$35,000 for Traditional scholarships. Selections are now complete and outlined below. We have some funds earmarked for continuing assistance to last year's Traditional scholarship awardees (amount included in the \$35,000) and will come back to you with that information once they present their transcripts and are interviewed in the summer months.

### IMPACT Scholarship Awards
