PHASE 2 SNOWNAKING AT SNOWPLAY BOARD MEETING 5/28/2021



- 1. Approve Phase 2 of the Snowplay Snowmaking Construction Project for a total not to exceed \$97,216.45.
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to enter into a construction contract with Snow Machines Inc. (SMI).



BACKGROUND

- Why is this project important?
 - "Insurance policy" protecting key association revenue
 - Experienced low snow/drought year for 4 of last 10 years. ROI shows complete recoup of investment after two low snow/drought years
 - Ensure reliable conditions for members and guests at one of our popular winter amenities during key utilization periods such as late December
- The Board approved Phase 1 construction not to exceed \$115,000 on October 23, 2020
- Phase 1 Completed for a total cost of \$102,758 in early December 2020
 - Successfully made snow at Snowplay for the 2020-2021 season
 - Would not have had Snowplay open for the 2020 Christmas holiday without snowmaking



ANALYSIS

- Town of Truckee has determined a use permit amendment is required
- 2020 snowmaking under a temporary use permit was considered a trial period
- No issues were reported during trial period
- All documents submitted expecting approval by end of summer 2021

OUTREACH

- Member notification mailed to all residents within 500ft of project
 - Prior to trial period snowmaking
 - No negative feedback



FISCAL IMPACT

- Phase 2 \$93,145 + \$2,714.5 contingency
 - Install remaining infrastructure for permanent snowmaking project
 - Purchase two dedicated fan guns for Snowplay
- Completely funded out of Development Fund
 - 2020 approved budget \$30,000
 - 2021 approved budget \$200,000

 - Ensure reliable conditions for members and guests at one of our popular winter amenities during key utilization periods such as late December
- The Board approved final design and permitting not to exceed \$100,000 on April 9, 2020
- Final design completed and permits pending



ANALYSIS

Two-Phase Installation Plan

- Phase 1 Proposed project requesting approval
 - Utility infrastructure setup
 - Construct pump house/utility shed to accommodate utility infrastructure and equipment storage
 - Includes equipment space and utility conduit for future ACAC backup generator
 - Snowmaking utility installation 2k trails with snowmaking
 - Provides snowmaking in teaching meadow and Night Hawk/practice hill loop
 - Provides snowmaking along Northfork Trail to Moondance Hut
- Phase 2 Future Project
 - Additional snowmaking utility installation
 - Provides snowmaking around full Rough Rider Loop (1km)

- CEQA Qualifies For Categorical Exemption
- Town of Truckee grading permit approved
- Nevada County Management Plan Required approved
- Nevada County Grading Permit pending
- Nevada County Building Permit pending



OUTREACH

Extensive member outreach conducted in 2020

- Direct mail notification and request for feedback sent to adjacent homeowners
- Email notification sent to property owners and membership on Feb. 11 and Feb. 18
- Four Demonstration and Q+A sessions held on Feb. 15 and Feb. 22
- Snowmaking guns and information poster put on display from over one month
- Social Media: Instagram story and posts published in February 2020
- Feature story in March 2020 issue of Tahoe Donner News
- Information portal created on website with 'request for feedback'
- 25 member comments received with 17 in favor of, six opposed and two with general questions concerning snowmaking
- 20 Likemoji Responses received, all positive (Feb. 15 to March 7)
- Presented project information and updated at the following 2020 board meetings: January, February and March



FISCAL IMPACT

- Phase 1 \$999,709 + \$89,371 contingency
 - Install infrastructure for snowmaking
 - Purchase two dedicated fan guns and ten stick guns
- Completely funded out of Development Fund
 - 2020 approved budget \$100,000
 - 2021 approved budget \$900,000
 - Additional Development Fund Request -\$139,286
