After discussion, the board provided direction to staff on the next steps, including increased space for dining, rental, administration, season lockers, and enough women's restrooms.

The Board of Directors reconvened at 2:30 p.m. to continue the Downhill Ski Lodge discussion on conceptual design item 5.

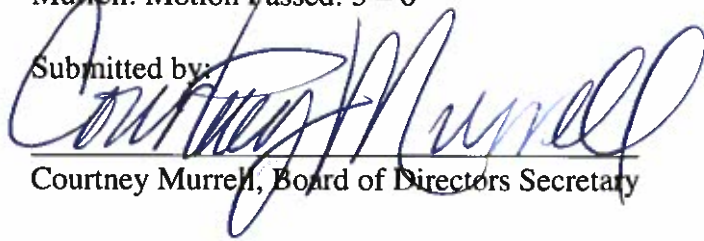
7. EXECUTIVE SESSION (closed to members)

At 5:15 p.m. Director Mahoney moved to adjourn the meeting seconded by Director Murrell. Motion Passed: 5 – 0

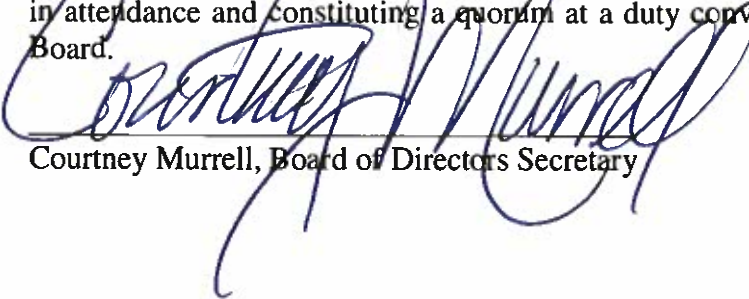
