Wildfire Mitigation

It's not a matter of whether the threat of forest fires will affect our community, but a matter of when. Our number one priority is to ensure the safety of our community, and that firmly rests on how we are managing our forest and defensible spaces. This is not just for the safety of our property and people, but also to ensure that our most precious amenity - our trails and open space - is preserved.

Financial Accountability

We need transparency and accuracy in all financial reporting so that we have a clear understanding of the costs and revenue from amenities. In addition, we must consider funding for replacement/reserve funds that is not solely based on member assessments

Amenity Relief

Tahoe Donner members are the first priority when it comes to member access of our amenities. I believe we should price access in such a way that drives revenue from public access, but does not diminish member access where appropriate.
