Trails Funding 1.0 Measure R



- Truckee Ballot measure in 2014
- Passed by supermajority at 76%
- Funds town's trail maintenance, helps building the Legacy Trail, and more.
- Funds maintenance on the town's trails including the much enjoyed winter snow removal.
- Expires June of 2024



Trails Funding 2.0

Measure U



- Polled at 76% voter support.
- Will be .5% sales tax, if passed. Bringing in \$3 mil annually.
- Renews and *enhances* funding for trails/bikeways (Adds < 3 cents to \$10 purchase, with exemptions.)
- Money stays in Truckee. Trails use only — by law!
- Finish Legacy Trail, and construct other trails, as well year-round maintenance.
- Everyone funds trails equally. Sales Tax.

Ballot Language Measure U



“Shall the Town of Truckee measure to continue protecting open space along trails; constructing the Truckee River Legacy Trail; building, repairing and maintaining trails, multi-use paths, and lanes for walking, hiking, biking and winter access; and providing safer routes to schools; by renewing the existing ¼% trails sales tax at a rate of ½%, providing approximately \$3,000,000 annually until ended by voters, with independent oversight, and all funds staying local to benefit Truckee, be adopted?”

Funds for Tahoe Donner Measure U



Funding possibilities for Tahoe Donner include:

- Help to build the remaining sections of the Trout Creek Trail.
- Enhance the safety of bicycle lanes on roads.
- Develop *safe routes to school* programs.
- Future connectivity trails within Tahoe Donner could be possible recipients of Measure U funds.
