



# APPLICATION PROCESS

Timeline depends on type of environmental review. If MND or EIR are needed, will depend on consultant timelines.

Consistency review: Does the project comply with the Town's standards?

**Environmental review:** What is the appropriate environmental review per the California Environmental Quality Act? Are there issues to disclose or mitigate?

- Categorical Exemption
- Mitigated/Negative Declaration
- Environmental Impact Report

**Public Hearing:** Only once all major issues related to consistency are resolved and environmental review is completed. **Date TBD.**

# TOWN'S ROLE

The Town does not advocate for a project. The Town does not review financial implications of a project.

#### Staff's Role

- Review the project for consistency with Town standards
- Work with TDA to revise the project, if necessary
- Identify any environmental impacts and any potential mitigation measures
- Provide a recommendation with any necessary conditions to the Planning Commission to ensure consistency

#### **Planning Commission's Role**

- Consider information provided by TDA
- Review the project for consistency with Town standards
- · Consider staff's recommendation and any recommended conditions of approval
- Consider any information provided by the environmental review
- Consider public comment
- Take action on the project: Amend, approve, deny, request more environmental review. Findings are required.

#### **Planning Commission Findings**

- ✓ Height

- ✓ Workforce Housing
- ✓ Design guidelines
- ✓ California Environmental Quality Act
- ✓ Adequate for public and emergency vehicle access, fire protection, sanitation, water and public utilities and services
- ✓ Site is suitable for the density/intensity of the development
- ✓ Nevada County Environmental Health Department & Truckee Fire Protection District.



#### Current Update:

 Town issued request for clarifying items after Town/agency project review September 9, 2022 "overall, with the information provided currently, the proposed project appears to substantially conform to the requirements of the development code"

- TDA resubmitted clarifying items including additional environmental reports November 2022
- Town of Truckee Procured Dudek (Environmental Consultant) for CEQA documentation November, 21 2022
- CEQA Kickoff meeting with Dudek and TDA December 1, 2022
- Expected draft Initial Study Mid-January
- After completion of initial study will have a better idea on remaining CEQA schedule, public review period, planning commission public hearing
