INSPIRED BY THE TAHOE DONNER GIVING FUND, ONE GENEROUS DONOR CREATED THE IMPACT SCHOLARSHIPS TO CHANGE LIVES

In 2017, one Tahoe Donner homeowner read about the TDGF scholarship students and came to us with an idea.

She told us, "I want to change someone's life by granting a full scholarship to a student in need, preferably first generation, to attend a college they might otherwise not be able to afford."

That was the beginning of the Tahoe Donner Giving Fund IMPACT Scholarship Program, launched in 2019 with four \$50,000 scholarships to recipients who have up to five years to complete their schooling.

To date, this anonymous donor's generosity is supporting the education of 16 scholars.

As one of the IMPACT scholars told us, "The Tahoe Donner anonymous donor is my angel sent from heaven. I am so very appreciative!"

THANKS TO YOUR GENEROSITY

In 2022, the Tahoe Donner Giving Fund (TDGF) awarded a total of \$278,000 in scholarships and grants through the Tahoe Truckee Community Foundation, which administers the TDGF: \$200,000 to four IMPACT scholarships, \$33,000 to ten traditional scholarships, and \$45,000 to thirteen nonprofit organization grants.
