
DEFENSIBLE SPACE PROGRAM UPDATES

- Adoption of FireAside Defensible Space Inspection Software
 - Provides more detailed and individualized defensible space report to homeowner with photos
 - Allows for greater communication/collaboration with Truckee Fire through shared visibility of inspections
- Zendesk Customer Service software added to better documentation and tracking membership requests and support needs
 - Software also used by Tahoe Donner Member Services, Downhill Ski Resort and TDXC



CURRENT FORMAT OF INSPECTION REPORT

- Hand drawn, hard to understand, does not allow for photos, requires members to call forestry staff for more information
- Existing defensible space files are all created and stored in paper format at the forestry building

1. Firewood within 30' of structures must be relocated

Firewood was observed within 30' of structures

Firewood, lumber or any combustibles should be stacked 30 ft. from the structure or any attachment to the structure. Firewood can be stacked closer if covered SECURELY with a fire-resistant tarp and stacked neatly on gravel or another non-burnable surface. Tarps must be in good condition without tears or holes, cover the firewood completely, to the ground with no gaps. Old or decomposed firewood must be removed. Firewood rounds cannot be left on property; wood must be split and stacked neatly.



NEW REPORT FORMAT – EXAMPLE TWO

All files are created and stored electronically. Homeowners can access files through the software, including detailed images, and clearly explain what needs to be done to be compliant

1. Create canopy spacing between trees 💌

Trees requiring removal to gain additional canopy spacing were observed

Trees are too dense and canopy spacing is required between some trees to prevent fire from spreading between canopies. Trees growing under the canopy of larger trees should be removed to prevent fire from spreading from the ground into the canopy of trees. Tahoe Donner Forestry Staff will visit to mark trees that must be removed.




CHIPPING PROGRAM ENHANCED + **RESERVATION NOW REQUIRED**

TWO CHIPPING DISPOSAL METHODS

- Grapple truck will focus on the current defensible space zone (highest pile density) and pick up large piles throughout the association and chip at Forestry location
- Chip truck will pick up piles throughout the association as needed and chip on-site





CHIPPING REQUIREMENTS – SAME FOR BOTH METHODS

A chipping reservation is now required in 2023. Please request a chipping pile pick-up here.

Materials to be chipped must be:

- Stacked with the cut or large ends facing the street
- In front of your home and stacked on the edge of the road, not on access easements
- Stack loosely, no higher than 4 feet
- Away from snow poles, fire hydrants, trees, landscaping or structures

Eligible material:

- Brush and tree limbs up to 8 inches in diameter, either green or recently dead
- Minimum of 2 feet in length
- Maximum 8 feet in length

Non-eligible material:

- Old, dead, hard branches with no bark attached
- Bark, pine needles and pine cones
- Roots or root wads (tree stumps)
- Scrap lumber
- Lot clearing for construction
- Garbage (trash)
- Metal or wire






DEFENSIBLE SPACE CONTRACTORS' USE OF THE CHIPPING PROGRAM

- Forestry staff sampled 77 contracts from 2022
- Of the 77 contracts, 52 itemized green waste disposal fees with an average of \$747
- Key takeaway: Members who use TDA chipping save approximately \$750




