

TDGF Committee Meeting – March 13, 2023 – 3:00 to 5:00 pm Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 3:04 p.m. by Chair, Nan Meek.

Attendance: A quorum was established with Committee members present, by zoom: Marcia Argyris, Diane Campbell, Monika DeMartini, Fred Hertlein, Nan Meek, Toni Moore, Betsy Noonen, Ashley Savageau. Chair Updates – Nan

- Minutes from the February 6, 2023 meeting were approved.
- Skyline Lau is interested in submitting an application to serve on the Committee.
- Regarding the Committee Handbook, Nan will provide an updated copy of the pie chart at the April meeting.

Financial Report – Marcia

- March TTCF account balances: \$146,743 Main Account
 \$ 36,912 Traditional Scholarship Account
 \$625,651 Impact Scholarship Account
- Approximately \$173,000 of \$183,000 is available for 2023 grants and scholarships.
- Our three primary fundraising efforts now total \$100,196.
- Marcia and Nan facilitated a discussion about the upcoming distribution of funds between grants and scholarships. There was general consensus around a 50/50 split. Nan will proceed with seeking TD Board approval to designate \$55,000 for scholarships (\$50,000 plus \$5,000 cushion).
- Nan and Marcia met with Steve, the TD Financial Controller. We can proceed with designating our annual fundraising cycle to begin on April 1 and end on March 31. Lastly, the TDGF Association account has a balance of approximately \$10,657. Steve will verify this amount.

Vice-Chair Updates – Marcia

• Marcia facilitated a discussion about a summer appreciation event for our top 50 donors. The group discussed both a late afternoon event or a Sunday brunch. Speakers may include both scholarship and grant recipients. More to follow.

Fundraising – Betsy

- Betsy, Ashley and Amanda are planning for the upcoming fundraising cycle. At this point, three major activities will include a Dog Mayor Competition (in place of the July Campaign), Giving Tuesday and the Annual Appeal.
- Diane would like to see the Committee coordinate a way to acknowledge donors who are not TD residents such as friends and/or other supporters.

Scholarships – Diane

- Students will soon have access to scholarship applications.
- The application review and selection process will begin around April 1. The review team includes Diane, Marcia, Monika and Toni.

Events - Suzanne

- Overall, the three speaker series events went well. Suzanne provided a breakdown of the ticket sales which totaled \$622.
- Suzanne graciously offered to coordinate the speaker series for the Winter of 2024.

Communications/Tahoe Donner News – Diane

- Diane thanked Nan and Fred for their article focused on thanking this past year's donors. The article will appear in the April TD News.
- Diane is drafting a May article that will showcase Jairo, an impact scholar who is in his sophomore year at University of Nevada at Reno. Jairo is majoring in engineering and computer science.

- Nan reported that she and Marcia attended a TD training session for Committee Chairs and Vice-Chairs. The training was informative.
