WHEREAS, the services of Justin Malley have recently been engaged in the capacity of Director of Finance and Accounting of Tahoe Donner Association;

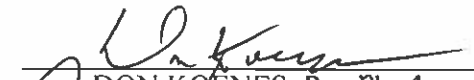
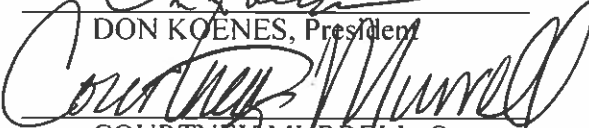
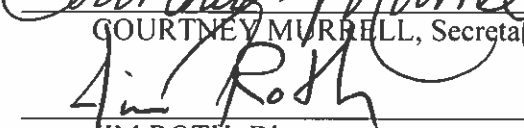
WHEREAS, The Board has found that the Association's best interests are served through the appointment of the Director of Finance and Accounting as Assistant Treasurer of the Corporation; and,

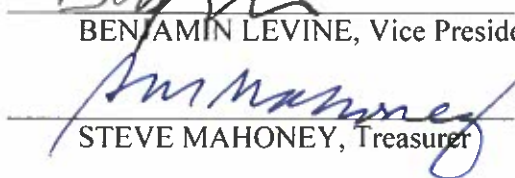
