Important Factors in an Emergency

- Preparation and Have a Plan
- Awareness and Communication
- Action

Examples of Common Questions from Members and Guests

- Where do I get information about the fire?
- What is my evacuation zone?
- What do the emergency evacuation notification levels mean (Evacuation Warning, Evacuation Order, Shelter In Place, Rescue)?
- Why is the power out?



Dear Tahoe Donner members,

We hope this message finds you safe and well. We wanted to take a moment to recap the events of yesterday's "**Pass Fire**" and to encourage all members to take proactive steps in preparing for future emergencies.

Pass Fire Recap: Yesterday afternoon, the Truckee Police Department issued evacuation warnings for several zones in and around Tahoe Donner, specifically TRK-E128, E118, E145, and E148. These warnings were disseminated via the CodeRED alert system, which provides timely updates during emergency situations. All Tahoe Donner Evacuation Warnings were lifted as of last night. At Tahoe Donner, we rely on the Town of Truckee and other official local agencies to keep our community informed during such critical events. We strongly encourage all members to register for these official communication channels to ensure you receive the most up-to-date information directly.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

To stay prepared and informed, we recommend that all members and visitors, at a minimum, take these steps:

- **Sign up for emergency alerts with CodeRED:** To ensure you're receiving real-time notifications during emergencies you can register here: <https://townoftruckee.gov/521/Emergency-Alerts---CodeRED>.
- **Identify your evacuation zone with Genasys Protect:** Knowing your evacuation zone is crucial. Find yours here: <https://protect.genasys.com>.
