PROJECTS UNDER CONSTRUCTION

DOWNHILL SKI LODGE REPLACEMENT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

WORK COMPLETED:

- Demolition
- Mass Grading/Earthwork
- Level one footings/foundation walls
- Underground utilities
- Temporary and permanent dewatering
- TDPUD waterline replacement project
- Site winterization

WORK IN PROGRESS:

- Level two footings/foundation walls
- Level one slab
- Temporary operations implementation
- Level 1 and level two waterproofing





CONSTRUCTION CHALLENGES:

- Dewatering
 - Zero groundwater to excessive over night. Unidentified existing culverts created challenges
- Unsuitable soils
 - Over excavation of all footings
 - Formwork required for all footings



DOWNHILL SKI LODGE REPLACEMENT SCHEDULE UPDATE

SCHEDULE HIGHLIGHTS:

- Approximately 6-weeks behind schedule due to challenging site conditions
- Poured Level 1 slab November 4th
- Resequencing order of work to go vertical November 25
- Utility work is complete closer to finished site work then planned eliminating below grade work next spring
- Schedule analysis underway to develop plan to get back on track


- Forecasted change orders to date \$548,944.90

GOLF CART PATH REPLACEMENT PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

- Phased approach
 - Phase 1 Front 9 & The Lodge and Golf Shop area – Substantially completed on June 19.
 Completing final grading and touch up in house November 2024.
 - Phase 2 Back 9 Substantially complete
 November 5. Shoulder work, asphalt curb and punch list items to be completed in May 2025.



BEACH CLUB MARINA DECK EXPANSION PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:


- Work commenced September 3
- Grading, underground utilities, ADA ramps and patio complete
- Bar construction in progress
- Scheduled for spring 2025:
 - Glass windscreen
 - Umbrellas
 - Bar equipment
 - Electrical switchgear
- On schedule for completion prior to Memorial Day wknd 2025



GLACIER WAY TRAILHEAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

- Tree removal completed in August
- Grading and paving completed in September and parking lot opened for use
- Signage installed in October
- Vault restroom installation scheduled for Spring 2025



PROJECTS IN PERMITTING


MAINTENANCE YARD FUEL STATION REPLACEMENT PROJECT

DESIGN & PERMIT UPDATE:

- Permit submitted
 - Planning concerned with construction over Public Utility Easement
- Re-design in progress, scope likely changing

CONSTRUCTION:


- Staff will come back to Board for new approval
- Construction postponed to 2025 pending permit



GOLF COURSE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE ON 18 PROJECT

PROJECT STATUS:

- Construction drawings complete
- CDFW Stream Alteration Agreement received
- Town of Truckee Permit comments received
 - Awaiting determinations from Army Corp & Lahontan to resubmit
- Construction pending permits, contractor availability and Board construction approval









PROJECTS IN DESIGN

ACAC NORTH PARKING LOT + ACCESS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT UPDATE

- Scope
 - North parking lot drainage improvements
 - Pave access road
 - Add staff parking where feasible
- Staff has developed Request for Proposal (RFP) for civil engineering, planning, and environmental



EUER VALLEY RESTORATION (COYOTE CROSSING)

PHASE 1 PROJECT

PROJECT UPDATE

- Pushing project to 2025
- Project lead is Truckee River Watershed Council (TRWC)
- Project costs continue to be over existing TDA capital funds and TRWC grant funding
- Update: TRWC requested an additional \$890k grant with the CA Wildlife Conservation Board. On CAWC Board consent agenda for November 21.
- Team will reevaluate the project after confirmation of additional funding



CLASS 1 MULTI-USE TRAIL PROJECT

PROJECT STATUS:

- Developing Request for Proposal for planning, design and permitting
- Working on reimbursement agreement with Town of Truckee



2024 PROJECTS PENDING

- Workforce Housing deferred until the implementation plan is finalized
- Mailboxes deferred to 2025
- Lodge Generator and Bar Shed -Construction deferred to 2026, will start design in 2025
- Northwoods Campus Master Plan
