

PROPOSED ELECTION AND VOTING RULES RULES CHANGE UPDATE

JANUARY 24, 2025



MEETING OUTCOME

The board will receive an update on the proposed Election and Voting Rules 45-day notice publication.

BACKGROUND PROPOSED RULE CHANGE PROCESS

The Elections Committee was tasked with reviewing the Election and Voting rules with legal counsel and proposing changes in 2024.

The Elections Committee completed this review in the fall and finalized the proposed rules in December.

January 9, 2025 Special Board Meeting: The Board of Directors authorized the publication of the proposed Election and Voting Rules change for a 45-Day Notice with all supporting materials necessary to inform the members about the purpose and effect of the rule change.



RULE CHANGE PURPOSE + EFFECT

The purpose of the proposed change includes:

- Ensuring that the Tahoe Donner Election and Voting Rules express the intent of new legislation today
- New rules format and reordering some of the existing rule language. Thus, the primary purpose is to replace the existing rules entirely with the proposed rules

RULE CHANGE EFFECTS

- Provide updated Election and Voting Rules to comply with state and association election regulations and restrictions and to clarify election practices
- Improved implementation of the election process at the Association

RECOMMENDED NEXT STEPS

- **45-Day Notice Development:** Proof complete with a delivery date to publishing house January 21, 2025.
- **45-Day Notice:** A special general delivery mailer was sent to the members to expedite the notice period start date. The goal is to postmark it by January 27, 2025.
- **Future agenda item:** The Board will hear member comments on the proposed rules change at the February 28, 2025 board meeting.
- **Future action item:** The Board may take action to adopt the proposed rules change in mid-March at a special board meeting following the 45-day notice period.
