

# Truckee Special Service Area 1 (TSSA 1) Funds



### TSSA 1 Background

- Parcel charge established by Nevada County
- Continued by Town of Truckee upon incorporation in 1993
- Properties within Tahoe Donner Subdivision:
  - \$95.00 per improved lot
  - \$70.00 per unimproved lot
  - \$597,000 per year
- Individual account, bears interest



#### **Allowable Uses**

- Roadway and drainage maintenance and improvement, including emergency preparedness and roadway safety infrastructure.
- Trail development and construction within and/or serving the TSSA 1 service area
- Enhanced snow removal
- Parking improvements in the Town right-of-way that provide direct benefit to the residents of the TSSA 1 service area and are open to the general public
- Design and construction of the Pioneer Trail/Bridge Street Extension Project
- Funds collected during the 19/20, 22/23, and 23/24 fiscal year are also eligible to use on transit
- Design and construction of emergency egress improvements
- Any change to use of TSSA 1 funds requires Truckee Town Council approval.



#### **Prior TSSA 1 Funded Projects**



- Tahoe Donner Roadway Vegetational Removal Project: Approx. \$1.2 million
- Parking on Alder Creek Road: Approx. \$300,000
- Trout Creek Trail: Approx. \$1.9 million
- Skislope Way Turnaround: Approx. \$56,000
- Donner Pass Road/East End Donner Lake Studies and Improvements: Approx. \$60,000





# Ongoing and Planned Use of TSSA 1 Funds

- Improved Maintenance on Tahoe Donner Roadways
  - Paving of Tahoe Donner local roads on approximate 20-year interval (vs. 30-year interval for rest of town)
  - Overlay Northwoods Boulevard loop on an 8-year cycle (vs. 15-year cycle)
  - Reserve Funding
  - \*Option to restructure the Improved Maintenance\*
- Special Projects (current or proposed in FY 25/26)
  - Tahoe Donner Trail (internal to Tahoe Donner, Tahoe Donner Project C2)
  - Tahoe Donner Roadside Vegetation Management
  - Tahoe Donner Emergency Egress Improvement Study

- Currently being updated




Figure 12: Anticipated 20-Year Paving Plan






5-year Pavement Maintenance Program



### 2025 Paving and Drainage Project

- Roadway repaving (green)
- Trail repaving (purple)
- Drainage improvements
- Recessed striping





# Option to Restructure Improved Roadway Maintenance

- Town is proposing to adjust the repaving interval on local roads from an Overall Condition Index (OCI) 60 to OCI 65 (appr. 30-years to 25-years) throughout Truckee
- New Town 25-year recurrence interval on local roads would provide appr. \$195,000 annually to TSSA-1 available for Special Tahoe Donner Projects
- Option: Match new Town local road repaving interval and change from OCI 70 to OCI 65 (appr. 20-years to 25-years)
  - Would provide approx. \$435,000 annually to TSSA-1 available for special Tahoe Donner Projects
  - No effect on Northwoods Boulevard/Collectors OCI 80 (appr. 8-year) repaving interval
- Town considered all TD local roads moving to 15-year repaving. Cost exceeds annual revenue of TSSA 1. Subset of roads may be considered.




## Tahoe Donner Special Projects



### Tahoe Donner Trail Project

#### **Internal to Tahoe Donner, Project C2**

- 4.5-mile long Class I paved trail through the Tahoe Donner subdivision
- Connects Trout Creek Trailhead with the Northwoods Clubhouse, Trout Creek Recreation Center, Alder Creek Adventure Center, and Downhill Skip Area
- Project C2 of the Tahoe Donner Trails Master Plan
- Design (\$750,000) proposed to be funded through FY27/28 using TSSA 1 funds
- Proposed reimbursement agreement with TDA staff performing the project management
- Construction currently unfunded





### Tahoe Donner Roadside Vegetation Management Project


- Project will provide increased roadside vegetation maintenance
- Project benefits:
  - Better fuel breaks
  - Increased evacuation preparedness by allowing for less roadside vegetation near existing vehicles
- Project led by TDA staff through a reimbursement agreement with Town





### **Tahoe Donner Emergency Egress** Improvement Study

- Feasibility study to evaluate improvements to emergency access and response in Tahoe Donner
- Improvements may include:
  - Additional access routes
  - Improvements to existing roadways
  - Communication upgrades
- Study led by TDA staff through reimbursement agreement with Town





# Northwoods Boulevard/Donner Pass Road Roundabout


- Preliminary design complete
- Draft Intersection Control Evaluation Report completed in 2020
- Project on hold with potential restart date in 2030





### **Pioneer Trail and Bridge Street Extension Project**

- Project update presented to Council in 2023
- Council directed staff to suspend work until community and staff capacity exists to conduct community polling
- Project estimated to cost \$42-\$50 million
- Next step is for community polling, specifically Tahoe Donner, to assess local funding source potential
  - Local funding source would likely be proposed as a Special Assessment District
- Project on hold with polling to potentially occur in 2026/2027






### **Active Transportation Plan Update**

NOTE: Depending on Town decision for repaving recurrence interval, available TSSA-1 Special Projects funds would increase to ~\$195,000 per year



#### Conclusion

- Town intends to conduct the TSSA-1 annual hearing in May
- Staff's current proposed recommendation (pending Council approval)
  - Maintain TD local road repaving interval at OCI 70 (~20-years)
  - Maintain Northwoods Boulevard/Major Collectors' approx. 8-year repaving interval at OCI 80
  - Retain assessment level
  - Retain eligible uses
  - Provides approx. \$200,000 per year available for TD Special Projects
- Budget Schedule
  - April 22, 2025: Initial Budget Review
  - May 27, 2025: Budget Workshop


- 2025 Paving and Drainage Project

- Coordination with Truckee Fire **Protection District**
- Focused on West End of Donner Lake
- Main evacuation roadways within Town limits
